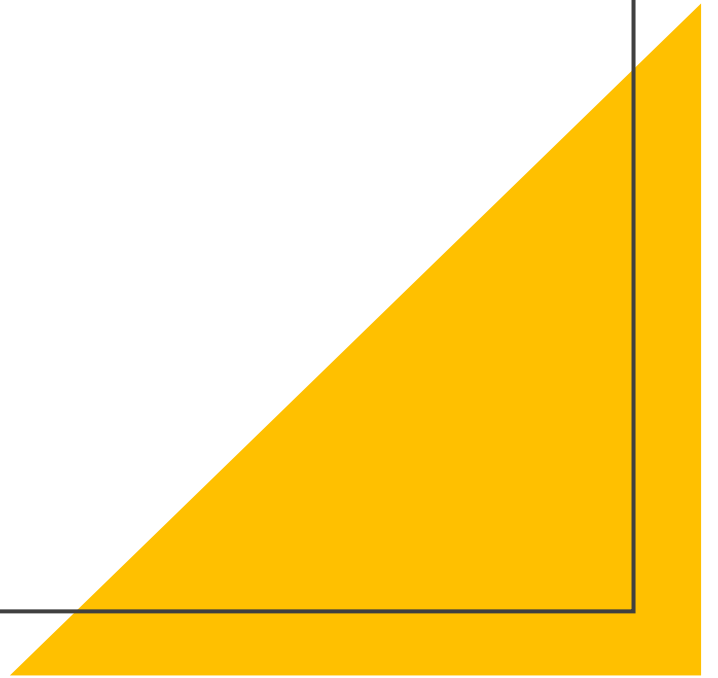

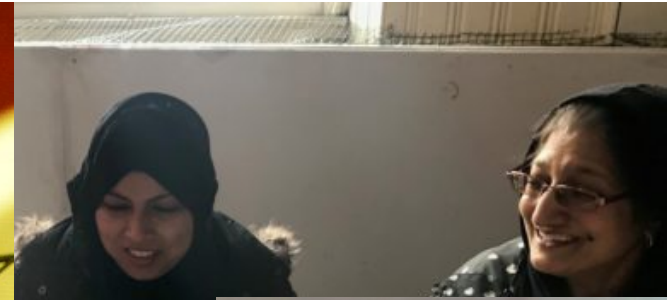

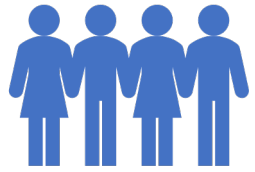

Sandra Bland, Eric Garner, Freddie Gray: the toll of police violence on disabled Americans

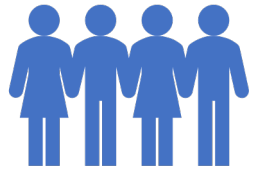
More than a third of Americans killed by police have a disability.
It's time to listen to black and disabled activists



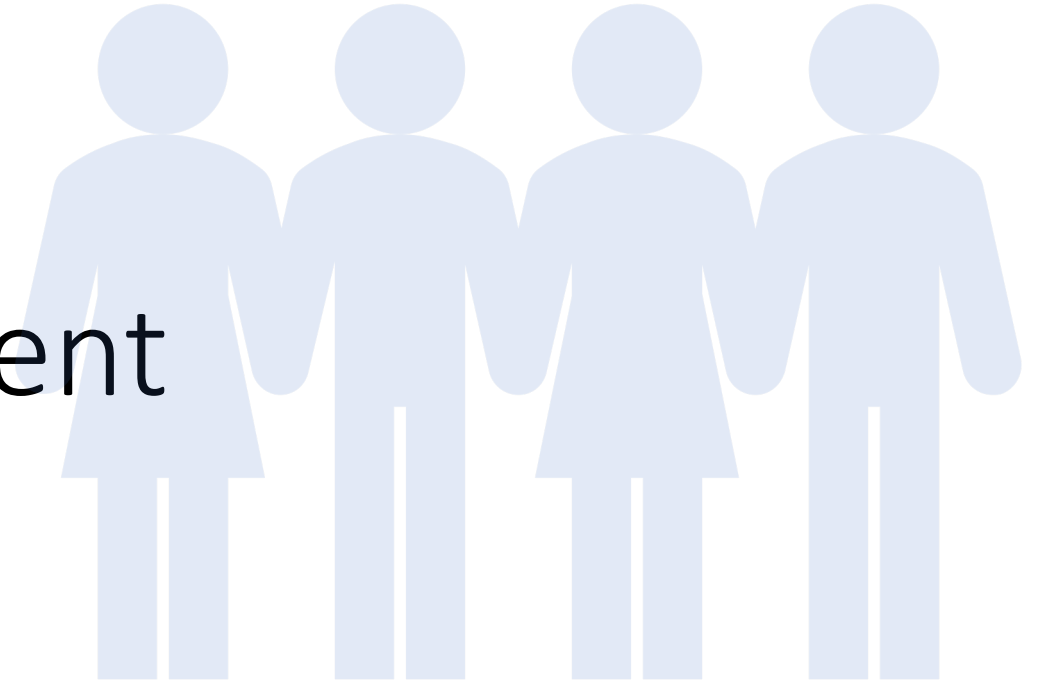
